





Kia ora Boulcott whānau,

Things have continued to tick along nicely here at school since returning from our 'little break'. Based on the Prime Minister's announcement on Monday, it looks likely that we will continue to remain in Level 2 through to the end of the term. Thanks once again for your support with our protocols around Level 2. Just a gentle reminder that during this time we are wanting to restrict the number of visitors that come on site. Please only do so if it is absolutely necessary. Ringing the school office and sending an email to the teacher will usually do the trick if you need to make contact with anyone at school.

Thanks also for keeping your child/ren away from school if they are unwell. We can see just how important this is when we look at the positive case that was present at school in the Waikato just last week.

This week your child/ren would have come home with a 'Learning at Home' kit that the classroom teachers have had packaged up, ready to distribute to whānau. With the snap decision to move to Level 4 last month we had no time to distribute these out to families. We have made the decision to pass these on to you now, so they can be stored at home, in case we are in the unfortunate position of having to provide distance learning again. PLEASE KEEP THESE IN A SAFE PLACE AT HOME AND ONLY USE THEM IF WE RETURN TO LEVEL 3 OR 4. Fingers crossed, they won't need to be utilised at all!


I am incredibly excited to announce that it looks like our redevelopment project of our Senior school looks set to commence at the beginning of Term 4. This is a significant project which will modernise Rooms 1, 2, 3 and 4, creating additional breakout spaces, make better use of the corridor and create additional decking. There will also be additions to the Kōwhai team (Middle syndicate) deck area, creating more sheltered outdoor spaces. While we have contractors onsite, we need to relocate classes so building work can be completed. Thankfully, the work will be completed in two stages. This means for the first stage, we only have to relocate Room 1, so Melissa Coton and her class will be moving to the school library for the final term of 2021. In the

New Year Rooms 3 and 4 will need to be relocated, but we will have more flexibility with spaces. This project has been in the planning phase for close to 2 years now, so it is really exciting to see the plans finally come to life! 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


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
