HALL PROJECT

Our Hall property project is progressing at a rapid pace! The first phase is continuing with work on the main entrance and road face of the school hall. This means our hall can still be used but we have restricted space. It is also very noisy! **SKIDS** (Before and After School Care) is operating between the hall and Room 14 currently. The contractors have managed to maintain a narrow entrance to our school office area. We are pleased this work is being carried out before Winter to prevent leaks!! Following completion of the hall, the second phase will begin. This will involve some classes and our admin area having to be vacated. Preyer Construction are confident this stage can be phased out so classes/spaces can be relocated in a staggered approach.

ASSEMBLIES

Due to the hall work, we are unable to have assemblies this term. There will be three live assemblies broadcast via Google Meets. Even though we are not able to meet, CHEER recipients will continue to be celebrated in our newsletters.

SUMMERSET ROAD WORKS

As mentioned in our community email last weekend, Summerset is working on the water mains in Boulcott Street. The road directly in front of our school has been completed, and work will continue from our crossing up to the High Street end. This will cause some disruption to drop offs and pick ups—we encourage families to park further away and walk/bike/scoot the rest of the way. Remember, our Walking Pou is a safe spot to drop kids so they can walk together from there. The contractors for this project will endeavour to have the street clear until 9am and just before 3pm. Please be aware that during the day parts of Boulcott Street may be closed.




