It was lovely to see so many of you come into school last week for our second set of Student Learning Conferences ( Parent and Teacher interviews). Thank you also to the 115 of you who responded to our end of year prize-giving ceremony. Based on your feedback we have a new proposal which the board are going to be looking at during our Board meeting next week. We will share the changes with you very soon.

#### Mihi Whakatau

Thank you to everyone that came along to the Mihi Whakatau this week - to welcome our new akonga/learners and their whānau to Boulcott School.

Our mihi whakatau involved our students participating in karanga and mihi, supervised by parents from the Whānau Rōpū, to give them experience and insight into some of the rituals of mihi whakatau.

Below is information on what the Whānau Rōpū does.

Whānau Rōpū

E ngā mana E ngā reo E rau rangatira mā Tēnā koutou.

The Boulcott School Whānau Rōpū was established in 2018 by the amazing Whaea Pania Dewes as a way to create relationships within the community, especially with Māori families, and to celebrate Te Reo (Māori Language) and Te Ao Māori (Māori World View) at Boulcott School.

Our current moemoeā (vision) for the school and our kids is that our tamariki feel that our culture is visible, valued and celebrated, and are given opportunities to engage with Te Ao Māori at Boulcott School.

Each year we undertake a number of initiatives which include:

- Ensuring Te Tiriti and Ka Hikitia Ka Hapaitia (Māori Education Strategy) is visible and represented in the school's strategic plan
- Welcoming new whānau with a Mihi Whakatau
- Hosting Matariki each year attracting over 300 people
- Fundraising
- Preparing our kids for Hutt Fest
- Kapa Haka for all tamariki
- Gifting a taonga to our Year 6 students as they leave Boulcott School
- End of year Pool Party
